The Student Council of St. John Regional School has traditionally been comprised of 10 junior high members. They have included the officers (President, Vice-president, Secretary, and Treasurer) as well as two class representatives from each of the three grades. One of those representatives is elected by his or her peers and the other is appointed by the junior high teachers.

The Student Council has provided leadership opportunities in our school which include fostering communication, recognizing potential areas for improvement, overseeing and planning dances, and considering and fulfilling needs for the less fortunate at various times of the year. They strive to create pride, represent the school by setting good examples, set standards for their peers, and foster cooperation.
